The Ipswich Cultural Council is part of the Mass Cultural Council, a state agency that fosters a rich cultural life for all Massachusetts residents, and contributes to the vitality of our communities and economy.

All artists ages 17 and older who currently live in Ipswich or work for the Town of Ipswich are invited to submit their work. Artists are encouraged to enter artwork in different medium: photography, textiles, video, ceramics and sculpture, as well as paintings and drawings.

Artists are allowed 2 entries for hanging and 3 unframed pieces for bin art. Works must be original, not copies and not previously exhibited at the Annual Art Show.

The ICC receives 20% of sale, the artist 80%.

Prizes will be awarded for different categories including "Best in Show" and the "People's Choice Award." The winners will be announced and all awards will be published in the Ipswich Local News.

Dear Ipswich Artist:

The Ipswich Cultural Council is pleased to announce the **37th Annual Ipswich Art Show & Sale**. This 3-day event showcases local talent and raises money for grants to fund community-based projects in the arts, humanities, and sciences. This is an un-juried show for entries; however, judges will be awarding cash prizes. The art show will take place October 6-8 at Town Hall, 25 Green St.

**Eligible Work** – All artists **ages 17** and older that are currently living in Ipswich or work for the Town of Ipswich are invited to exhibit their work. Artists are encouraged to enter artwork in different media, such as photography, textiles, video, ceramics, and sculpture, as well as paintings and drawings.

Artists May Submit:

- Two (2) pieces per artist, with AT LEAST one of the two pieces submitted, being FOR SALE.
- Bin art: Three (3) shrink-wrapped pieces in addition to your two framed submissions.
- Works must be original, not copies and not previously exhibited at the lpswich Art Show.
- All submitted artwork must be ready for display or will not be accepted. All pieces must be "ready for hanging" with appropriate framing and properly attached screw eyes and wire sufficient to hold the piece. We will accept oversized unframed items (over 3'x5'), and excessively heavy pieces, but only if they are ready to hang with the appropriate wiring for size and weight.
- Video installations are encouraged. Presentation equipment must be provided by artist.

**No late entries or walk-ins will be accepted.** Bring your payment to the art drop off at the Town Hall gym on Weds, October 4th between 5-7 pm, provided your registration has been submitted online or delivered/or postmarked to Ipswich Photo by Thursday, Sept 28th.

**Entry Fees** – The entry fee is \$10 per submission. (bin art has no entry fee)

**NOTE: ALL FEES TO BE PAID AT DROP OFF.** A maximum of two pieces may be submitted per artist. Please have your check ready (made payable to ICC) or cash. **No late entries or walk-ins will be accepted. There is no fee for bin art.** 

Vendor Space and Fees – Artist vendors may sell their work on Sat. and Sun. on a first come, first serve basis. Vendor space is available only to those who exhibit AT LEAST one piece FOR SALE in the Art Show. Space is limited. Fee is \$35 for two days or \$20 for one day, payable at time of artwork drop off. Make checks payable to the ICC.

Vendors are responsible for their own art and transactions. The ICC will take no commission from vendor sales. Vendors may sell during art show hours. All displays are the responsibility of vendors. Questions, contact Mike McGrath at Email: ditherson7@gmail.com or by phone at 978-356-7972.

DROP OFF of Work – Weds, October 4th 5-7 pm. The Town Hall Gym, 25 Green Street. Be sure to bring all included registration paperwork with you at Art Drop-Off. Keep each receipt, as it is needed for pick up. <u>Note: All</u> work must be ready for hanging with proper hardware (i.e., eyehooks with wire). All entry fees are due at this time, including vendors.

PICK UP of Work – Sun., October 8th, 4–5:30 pm. You must make an arrangement with Mike at time of drop off, if you **ABSOLUTELY will not** be able to pick up your work. It is not the responsibility of the Ipswich Cultural Council or the Ipswich Town Hall. It will be left in the gym and could be discarded if not claimed. This includes purchased artwork.

Artist's Disclosure– The art show committee will have volunteers in attendance at all times during the hours that the show is open. The Ipswich Cultural Council, art show volunteers, the Trustees of the Ipswich Town Hall, will NOT be responsible for any loss or damage to the artwork, during or after show hours. NOTE: ALL ARTISTS ARE REQUIRED TO SIGN A WAIVER. Artwork will not be accepted without a signature. Vendors are included in this disclosure. VOLUNTEERS NEEDED!! Sign up to volunteer when you drop-off your artwork.

VOLUNTEER SIGN-UP SHEETS will be on the table the night of drop-off. Without your help, we cannot make this event a success. Exhibitors are asked to volunteer for one or more of the following:

- Moving panels: Wed., October 4<sup>th</sup>, 10am
- Pickup Decor and Decorating: Thurs., October 5<sup>th</sup>.
- Monitoring gallery and coordinating artwork purchases during show: 2-hour time slots
- Taking down show, put away panels: Sun., October 8th, 4 pm
- - Prizes Monetary prizes will be awarded in several different categories including "Best in Show" and the "People's Choice Award." The winners will be announced on Friday evening, except for the People's Choice which will be announced in the Ipswich Local News with other prize winners.

Direct Art Sales – All art purchases will be made with gallery monitors. No artwork will be sold off the wall; artwork must remain for the duration of the show. Purchased artworks can be picked up at the end of the show on Sun., October 8th between 4-5:30pm. When pricing your work, please keep in mind that the buyer will make a separate tax-deductible donation of 20% of the sale price to the lpswich Cultural Council, and the artist will receive a payment of 80% of the sale price.

- 4. Artwork must be properly framed and wired for hanging. PLEASE, make sure your wire is on properly and does not extend above the frame when hung. If your piece is on unframed canvas or the like, it too must be properly wired.
- 5. Please have the "receipts" attached to the FRONT of each entry.
- 6. PAYMENT for entries is due at drop-off.
- 7. Drop-off is October 4th between 5 and 7 PM at Ipswich Town Hall. Pick up is October 8th between 4 and 5:30. You must make an arrangement with Mike at time of drop off, if you ABSOLUTELY will not be able to pick up your work.
- 8. Remember: VOLUNTEER SIGN-UP SHEETS will be on the table the night of drop-off. There are many ways to help make the art show & sale happen, so sign up for when and where you might help.
